Kitchen of Las Patronas presents the remarkable journeys made on "The Beast", a train route through Mexico, where some of the region's most vulnerable migrants perch perilously on top of freight carriages for days. The tracks pass by the town of La Patrona in Southern Mexico, where a group of women have taken it upon themselves to provide fresh meals to those on the move. Initially acting purely from compassion, in learning about the migrants, Las Patronas also discover more about themselves, their rights, and their role as women.
